

Mileage Warranty for the Canadian market:

The Continental brand tires listed below are warranted against wearout up to the kilometer coverage indicated, even though the actual kilometers you may get from your tires may vary because of driving habits and road conditions. Subject to the provisions of Section 4 in the Total Confidence Plan, if one of the tires listed in this section wears out before the stated kilometer coverage, CTA will warrant the tire on a pro-rata basis as indicated herein. "Wearout" means that the tire's tread has worn evenly down to the tread wear indicators (2/32nds of an inch or 1.6 mm of tread remaining.) "Pro-rata" for this Mileage Warranty is measured by the odometer readings at the time of the tire's purchase*, as shown by the original tire receipt and proof-of-purchase, and the odometer reading at the time of replacement. In addition, you must present a fully completed, legible Rotation Schedule, which is found in the original owner's copy of the Total Confidence Plan.

- Tire(s) that have not been rotated at least every 10–13,000 Kilometers, as evidenced by a completed Rotation Schedule, are excluded from this coverage.
- On vehicles with staggered / split fitments (different size tires on front and rear axle), tires cannot be rotated between the front and rear axle. Without rotation of tires between the front and rear axle, the expected kilometers before wearout is significantly lower, especially on the rear axle. Therefore, the Mileage Warranty for tires on the rear axle of these vehicles will be 50% of the standard Mileage Warranty for the product line.
- Tire(s) in service for more than 72 months, regardless of mileage, are not covered.
- The owner pays shipping, mounting, balancing and all applicable taxes under the Mileage Warranty.
- Tires used in commercial service, competition or tires received as original equipment are not eligible for extra coverage.

The owner pays shipping, mounting, balancing and all applicable taxes under the Mileage Warranty. Mileage warranties vary by tire line.

***A "comparable" new Continental brand tire may be of either the same tire line or the same basic construction but with a different sidewall or tread configuration. The Limited Warranty covers tires of equal or lesser value. If customer accepts a higher priced tire, customer is responsible for covering any difference in price. Any tire replaced under this Limited Warranty will be covered by the current Limited Warranty.*
